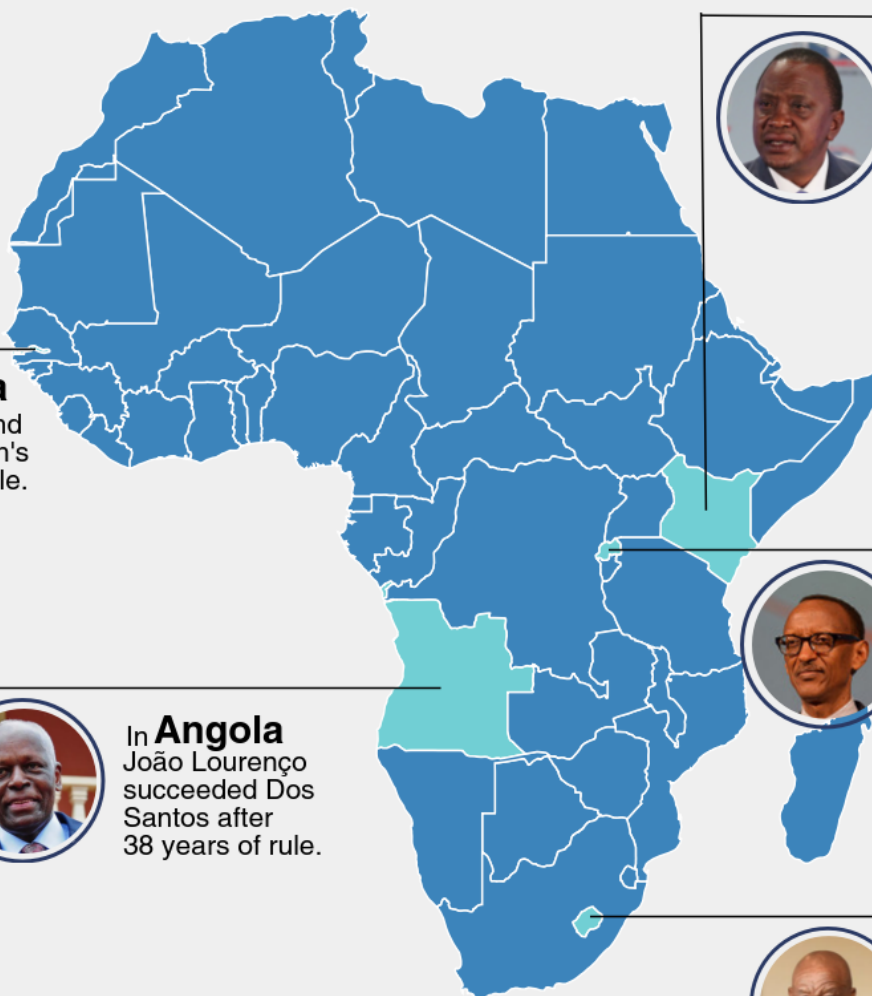

saw the end of Jammeh's 22-year rule.



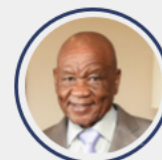
In **Angola**
